(37e12.com), with six units, like a three-bed, three-and-a-half bath apartment listed for \$17.75 million; and Tribeca's 60 White St. (60white.com), containing eight units, with a 3,000-square-foot, three-bed, three-bath penthouse asking \$9.265 million.
