## 1. WILLIAMSBURG \$1,575,000

74a Conselyea Street got some attention for its heavy-duty reno, even its own WSJ profile! This townhouse was a "hell hole" before it was bought for \$800,000, gutted and redone, becoming an owner's triplex with two more rental units. The cellar holds a laundry room and recording studio, there's a glass sun room and a private garden, red-cherry wood floors and African mahogany cabinets. (Check out this <u>slideshow</u>.) And what do ya think of that facade, which <u>Curbed</u> called "One of Williamsburg's funkiest?" The listing went up in August for \$1.695 million. Now that it sold, it comes just second to most expensive townhouse sales in Williamsburg, right after <u>180 Bedford</u>. Entered into contract on 9/30/10; closed on 11/4/10; deed recorded on 11/16/2010.
