CORE's Emily Beare is making a big change at the 141 Fifth Avenue Cupola residence.

Beare is re-listing the \$12 million triplex two bedroom cupola with a neighboring three bedroom penthouse to create a one-off home she's pricing at \$17.5 million.

The combination home creates a six bedrooms, 6.5-bath 5,600 s/f home with over 1,100 s/f of private terrace space.

"There are many possible configurations depending on specific needs, but all would offer the unique opportunity of owning and living in one of only a handful of residential cupolas in the city," said Beare.

+ aRt, the new condo in West Chelsea's art district, and Chashama, an organization that transforms donated retail storefronts into art exhibitions, have opened a third art exhibition: An Island Now Peopled, which will run thru December 11.
