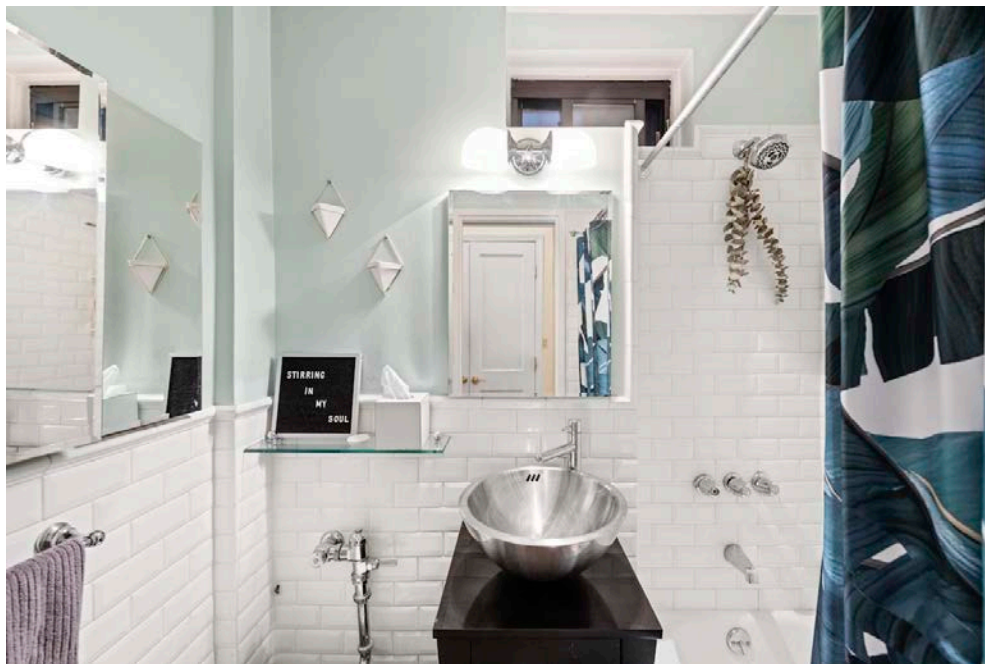
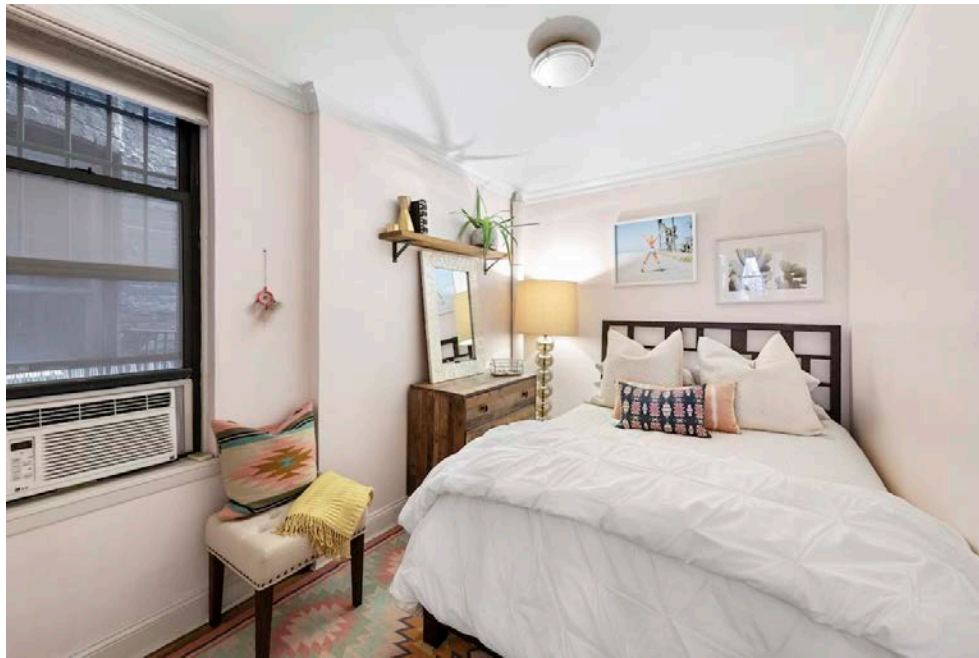

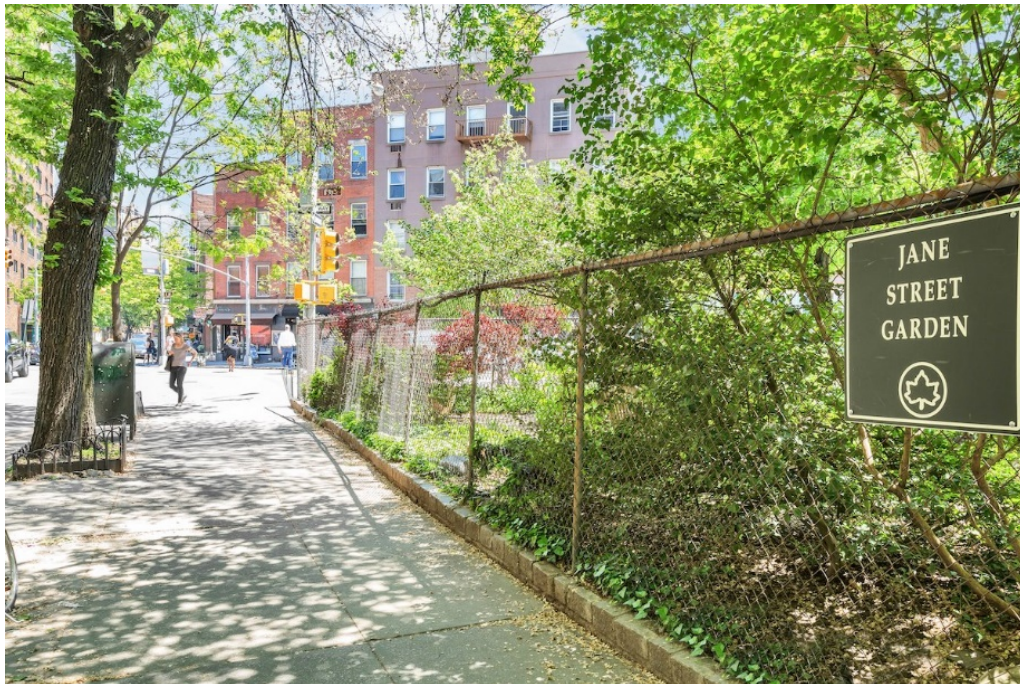
There's no funny business about the layout: There's an open living room, a kitchen and an actual, though small, bedroom—and closets just where they're needed.
