In Soho, a stunning penthouse with six skylights wants \$5.125M

This apartment is bathed in light thanks to 12 arched windows that look out on to the street





Located on the top floor of a six-story loft building on the border of Soho and Nolita, this stunning, 2,500-square-foot penthouse is now on the market for \$5.125 million. There's lots to love about this airy penthouse, but lets start with the 12 arched windows that look out on to Crosby Street and bathe the apartment in light.

Adding to that sense of airiness are the six skylights spread out throughout the apartment, some of which are operable (!!). The one in the kitchen is probably a big boon; that space also comes fitted with black granite countertops and backsplashes, cabinets made with reflective etched glass (the upper ones), and a vented hood and in-sink garbage disposal.

The apartment features a total of three bedrooms, and two-and-a-half bathrooms, though one of the bedrooms is currently set up as a library with features like floor-to-ceiling oak bookshelves, and a sliding ladder.









The library is on the opposite end from the master suite, which has a large walk-in closet, and an adjoining master bath that comes fitted with a steam shower, a double vanity, and a deep soaking tub.

Other standout features in the penthouse include the 11.6-feet-tall ceilings, the restored wooden beams and columns, and the oak flooring. For all of that, this place wants \$5.125 million.
