A corner co-op in Chelsea comes with an all-white updated kitchen and a classic-looking subway tiled New York bathroom. The apartment's large bedroom has a substantial sized walk-in closet that provides the bulk of the storage for this space. The many windows in this apartment overlook neighboring gardens, and the apartment is a short walk from the Whitney Museum of American Art. Core has the \$799,000 listing. Monthly maintenance runs \$1,153.
