A light-filled co-op located within the lush Linden Court complex in Jackson Heights is now on the market for \$439,000. The one-bedroom, one-bathroom unit has large windows in the living room that look out on to the complex's central garden. The living room also has lovely built-in shelves that are great for storing a variety of objects. Tucked away in a little corner just beyond the living room and dining room is the apartment's cozy kitchen. The blue cabinetry and the brick wall really make the space pop, and the window brings in a good amount of light as well. Aside from that, the kitchen has stainless steel appliances, and reclaimed wooden shelving.
