These homes have the best views in New York City

As the omnipresent crush of tourists proves, New York is not lacking in sights to see. The Empire State Building, the Brooklyn Bridge, the Statue of Liberty — when it comes to landmarks, the city is loaded. But what if you could take them in ... without having to go out?

The Brooklyn Bridge is one of the loveliest landmarks in the city, and this two-bedroom on the 12th floor of Dumbo's Clock Tower building offers front-row seats to the show. Enjoy unobstructed views from the living room and both bedrooms.

Commitment-phobes, never fear. A unit on the same floor (two beds and two baths over 1,414 square feet) is on the rental market for \$7,500/month and offers similarly sweeping views of the bridge and Manhattan skyline.

If it's variety you're looking for, just head upstairs to the building's landscaped terrace where you'll find the Manhattan Bridge — no slouch itself — awaits.
