GREENWICH VILLAGE, NY — For less than \$1 million, a one-bedroom apartment designed by Nate Berkus and Jeremiah Brent in Greenwich Village could be yours.

At 2 East 12th St. just east of Fifth Avenue, Berkus and Brent have designed the one-bedroom apartment that features a marble fireplace, according to the listing.

The stylish digs is up for grabs for \$800,000.

The brownstone built in 1900 sits at East 12th Street and Fifth Avenue and was home to the renowned interior designers Berkus and Brent until they listed the apartment this week, People magazine first reported.

Interested buyers can purchase the space fully-furnished for extra cash, People wrote.

The one-bedroom, one-bathroom apartment offers nearly 11-and-a-half foot ceilings and three south-facing windows.

The apartment is in a 10-unit cooperative building near Union Square and Washington Square Park.
