PEDIGREE: Set roughly 20 miles southwest of Dublin, this circa-1740 Georgian manor—named Furness—was devised by architect Francis Bindon and is

currently owned by brewery heir Patrick Guinness. Behind the handsome limestone façade lie grand rooms with their original charms intact, among them carved pearwood and marble mantelpieces and elaborate moldings.

PROPERTY VALUES: The verdant 34-acre grounds include a stable and a staff cottage as well as other outbuildings.

TALKING POINT: History buffs will delight in the estate's sixth-century chapel, constructed by early Christians.

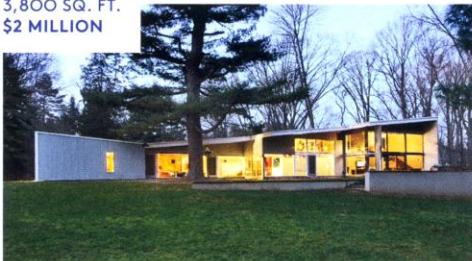
PEDIGREE: In the early 1950s, modernist pioneer Marcel Breuer built the Lauck House, a striking glass-and-steel residence modeled after a prototype he erected in the garden of New York's Museum of Modern Art. Expanded in the '80s, the home has been lovingly restored by its current owners.

PROPERTY VALUES: Surrounded by scenic woodlands, the four-acre parcel is located just minutes from downtown Princeton.

TALKING POINT: Only period-appropriate paint colors and stains were used in the structure's meticulous revamp.

PROPERTY VALUES: The 16th-floor apartment boasts a private 450-square-foot terrace and shared access to a rooftop lounge, a screening room, and a gym, plus myriad other amenities.

TALKING POINT: Floor-to-ceiling windows offer vistas in every direction, putting much of the city within sight.
