Flegg has star turn in reality TV show

IS BRUCE Flegg eyeing a career as a reality TV star?

The LNP MP has been featured on a US reality television show that chronicled the purchase of his swank, \$1.2 million Fifth Ave apartment.

Before their relationship went sour, Mr Flegg dispatched his former lover Sue Heath to the Big Apple to buy him the Manhattan pad. The Member for Moggill allowed the process to be documented for the series *Selling New York*.

The show, which airs in Australia on Foxtel, follows real estate agents as they navigate the cut-throat Manhattan

property market. In the episode, filmed last year, Dr Flegg's then girlfriend, Ms Heath, works with real estate agent Mickey Conlon to secure "an iconic" New York apartment with a budget of US\$600,000-\$800,000.

"My partner Bruce loves property, it's a little hobby of his, and I said to him 'If you

want to buy property anywhere in America it should be New York'," Ms Heath said in an on-air interview.

However Mr Conlon is dubious about their prospects of finding a suitable property in that price range.

After viewing several properties Ms Heath sets her heart on a \$1.7 million apartment at 400 Fifth Ave.

They consult with Dr Flegg in Queensland via video link.

The politician asks Mr Conlon what the seller's reaction would be to an offer of \$1.2 million.

They eventually buy an apartment in the same building for \$1.2 million, around twice their original budget.
