



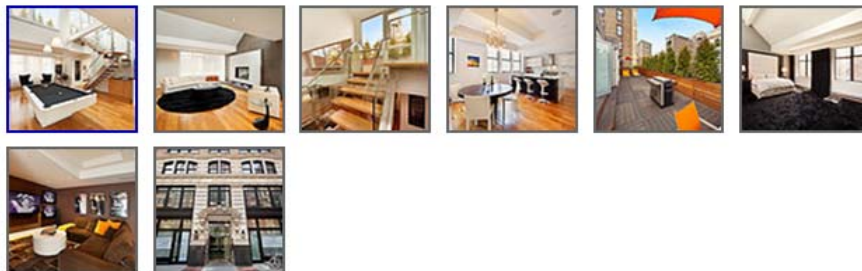

The floor-through layout offers three bedrooms including an oversized master suite, a large media room featuring a wall of five flat-screen TVs, four and half stunning bathrooms plus a home office with bathroom en suite. The eat-in kitchen features professional appliances, tremendous storage and a marble island with wine cooler as well as space for a full-sized dining table. One flight upstairs, the roof deck is fully equipped with enclosed hot tub, sound system and gas grill.

Not bad for a quiet ballplayer batting .229, right? Now if only Wright would donate the proceeds to the team's operating budget, then Mets fans would really have something to cheer about.
