

Nate Berkus Puts NYC Apartment on the Market for \$699,000 (House of the Day)

This apartment in Manhattan's Greenwich Village is just a one-bedroom, one-bath. But where it lacks in space, it makes up in style. Designed and renovated by Oprah darling Nate Berkus, the West Village place was featured in O Magazine and was recently listed for sale at \$699,000.

According to property records, Berkus bought the home in 2006 for \$550,000, and he owns another home in New York — a larger, 3,000-square-foot property — that he picked up in 2011. The designer

recently became engaged to his longtime boyfriend, Jeremiah Brent. The two bought a

house in late 2012 in <u>Hollywood Hills, Calif.</u>, and may be calling the Golden State home for a while.

The western-facing apartment in NYC has "views of one of the most charming corners of the Village." Berkus' updates to the home include a renovated kitchen with new appliances and a bathroom with Carrera marble floors, white subway tile and vintage hardware.
