That the Kips Bay Opening Night Cocktail Reception was held last night at the Mansion on Madison ... that Shaun Osher, CEO of Core, was honored last night by the Union Settlement Association, East Harlem's oldest social service association, at Gustavino's ... that a rare Egyptian Ptolemaic Period mummy sarcophagus, circa 332-330 BC, was taken out of a three-bedroom apartment at 30 Sutton Place and sold for \$60,000 at Capo Auction Fine Art and Antiques in Long Island City. It had been purchased for \$3,000 in the 1980s from Sam Haddad Egyptian Antiquities, which has long been out of business. The auction house estimates had been \$5,000 to \$7,000.
