It brings back the sweetest memories of my childhood and the stories my Dad would tell me about growing up Italian in Brooklyn. *Meatball & Spaghetti "della Nonna"* (\$18.95) is better than, well, Nonna's. (Sorry, Nonna!) I often opt for the scrumptious *Chinese Chicken Salad* (\$18.95). The *Triple Layered Fresh Coconut Cake* (\$10.95) is the best in the world! I believe scientists have proven this to be true. And what's nicer than opening your door to find a waiter in a white coat delivering your heavenly bounty?"
