## One of Williamsburg's Funkiest Facades Hits the Market Thursday, August 5th, by Sara





We're not sure which is more surprising about the listing for Williamsburg's 74A Conselvea Street: that TV star brokers CORE are handling a 'Burg listing east of the BQE, or what that listing actually looks like. The "architecturally significant" facade looks a bit like a mashup of a house and a high school, while the interiors—an owner's triplex and two rentals—seem in line with the rest of the Alden Maddry Architect portfolio. Owner Dana Bushman paid \$800,000 for the place in 2004 and loved it enough to keep a blog about it, but apparently not enough to hang onto it any longer. It's now asking \$1.695 million.
